New Windows & Doors in Kavadarci Primary School

USAID, as a part of the U.S. mission in Macedonia, is investing \$3 million in school renovations throughout the country. In the "Goce Delchev" Primary School in Kavadarci, new windows and doors were installed. The completion of the project was celebrated with a ribbon-cutting ceremony on May 4th.

"It's great to see how the school community and Municipality have worked together in partnership with the Primary Education Project to provide a better environment for education and the development of children" said U.S. Embassy Political Officer Amanda Timko. "School renovations are only a part of how the United States is working to improve education in Macedonia."

The renovation component of the USAID Primary Education Project supports the creation of better learning environments and decentralization of school facilities to municipal governments. The project also works to increase the access to and use of information technology and to improve the quality of math and science education in Macedonian primary schools.
